## AREA OF EMPHASIS

Appearance and Grooming	Proper grooming and a professional appearance are important steps in making a good first impression. What you wear and how you carry yourself speaks volumes about your personality. You are not judged solely on your exam results and knowledge.
Communication Ability	Using the right vocabulary to convey the right meaning.
Intelligence & Maturity	Applying Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) to display intelligence and maturity in any conversation and discussions.
Confidence & Interpersonal skills	Equip candidates with relevant knowledge on current issues to enable them to mix socially in informal and formal occasions involving various levels of society.
Working Experience	Possessing drive to achieve the desired goals. Able to display the working experience gained and how it benefits the interviewee in any particular situations.
Motivation & Ambition	To have clear visions and goals and the means to achieve them in the shortest possible time applying limited resources available.
Adaptability	Able to adapt to all situations in whatever circumstances, be it formal or informal.

### Contributions

- 1977- Major Hussin was entrusted to expose and train the first formal course of Pegawai Tadbir Diplomatik (PTD) officers of Institut Tadbir Negara (INTAN) held at Pusat Latihan Darat (PULADA).
- 1979-1982- Major Hussin was appointed by the Ministry of Defence (MINDEF) as the first assistant Army Attache to serve in the Malaysian Embassy, Washington D.C. Besides, he was also accredited to the U.S. Navy and Airforce apart from the army. In his capacity as the Assistant Army Attache, he was responsible for taking care of all the military students on course in the U.S. and official military visits of dignitaries from Kuala Lumpur. Apart from that, he maintains good liaison with the United States military officers in the PENTAGON ( U.S. military headquarters). As and when required, he has to attend commonwealth military meetings and joined the Annual Armed Forces Attache Tour to U.S. military establishments including Alaska.
